









Shudh Labh Home Composting using Bioclean

<p>The Shudh – Labh Aerobic Composting Kit Options</p>	 <p>30 Ltr GREEN BIN 55 Ltrs Blue Drum</p>	<p>Green Bin</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 9 ltr bucket with lid • 16 inch bottom plate • 2 Bioclean bricks • 30 ltr bin with lid • Neem Powder • Spinach Seeds • Family of 2 or 3 persons <p>Blue Drum</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 9 ltr bucket with lid • 19 inch bottom plate • 3 Bioclean bricks • 55 ltr blue drum with lid • Neem Powder • Spinach Seeds
<p>STEP 1 : Setting up a 9 inch base bed</p>		<p>Set up the container by adding crushed dry leaves or plain (no print) cardboard pieces. All all of the compost provided in the 9 ltr green bucket. Add four handfuls of powdered Bioclean into the bin to create a nice 9 inch bed.</p>
<p>STEP 2: Powdering Bioclean and Grow Brick</p>		<p>Soak the Bioclean brick in 1.5 litres of water for minimum 3 hours. Break the soaked brick into powder.</p>
<p>STEP 3: Adding Kitchen Waste and Cover it with Bioclean</p>		<p>Add daily kitchen waste (any veg or non veg food waste, used coffee/tea ground, crushed egg shells etc) . Always ensure that water has been drained from the kitchen waste. Cover it with 2 to 3 handful of bioclean. Add a handful of crushed dry leaves to cover the kitchen waste completely.</p>

<p>STEP 4: Remove moisture from the lid</p>		<p>While adding the kitchen waste to the composting bin, If there is a layer of moisture on the inner side of the lid, remove or wipe the moisture with a dry cloth. Once or twice a week, sprinkle one tea spoon of neem powder which helps reduce insects.</p>
<p>STEP 5 : Harvesting Compost</p>		<p>Once the bin is full, keep it aside for 3 to 4 weeks. Harvest nice earthy smelling compost after drying it. Half of the compost can be reused during the next composting cycle, while the other half can be used to grow vegetables.</p>
<p>STEP 6: Use Compost to grow Spinach or use in Gardening</p>		<p>Mix the harvested compost with red soil at 2:1 and grow your own Spinach using the seeds provided in the kit. Compost can be used for gardening or at a nearby park.</p>
