





Leaf and Flower Composter Setup Guide

<p>Setting up Leaf and Flower Composter</p>		<p>Process steps to maintain 5 ft or 3 ft diameter leaf composters</p>
<p>STEP 1 : Add dry leaves upto 1/3rd of the composter</p>		<p>Add a few sacks of dry leaves per week (Five sacks for a small composter – 3 ft diameter, 10 to 12 sacks of dry leaves for large composter – 5ft diameter)</p>
<p>STEP 2 : Add about 5 to 20 kg of compost</p>		<p>Spread about 5 to 10 kg of compost</p>
<p>STEP 3 : Add Diluted Essential Microorganism (EM1) solution</p>		<p>Add One litre of Essential Microorganism (EM1) solution diluted in 10 ltrs of water</p>

**STEP 4: Add
microbes**



Sprinkle Cow dung slurry (10 Ltr cow dung mix in 30 Ltr water) or EM1 solution (1 Ltr EM1 solution diluted in 20 Ltr water) or one 5kg bioclean block soaked in 10 Ltr water)

**STEP 5: Add
Flowers,
Vegetable Peels**



Flowers, donne, banana leaves, vegetable peels, fruit peels, used coffee or tea ground, compost can be added.
